Condoover Hall Residential Trip – June 2027

We are delighted to inform you of an exciting opportunity for your child when they move into Year 6. We are planning a multi-activity residential trip to **Condoover Hall** in Shrewsbury, Shropshire, taking place from **Wednesday 30th June to Friday 2nd July 2027**, with the children departing on Wednesday morning and returning on Friday afternoon.

This residential will give pupils the chance to learn beyond the classroom in a new and stimulating environment. Through a wide range of activities, children will develop teamwork skills, independence, confidence, and resilience. They will also have the opportunity to recognise and build on their personal strengths, while learning to face challenges constructively. Trip Details

- **Cost:** £380 per pupil
