

Y8 History - Chronology

To create a timeline of key historical events in Britain during the period 1500-1750

Chronology is the arrangement of events in time and it is important to understand where certain periods in history fit in time.

You must research Britain during the period 1500-1750 and create a clear and detailed timeline of that period.

Success criteria:

- Clear to read and neatly presented (handwritten or produced on the computer).
- Key events during that period listed chronologically
 - 8 Blake and Chaucer – 8 key events
 - 8 Shakespeare – 6 key events
 - 8 Tennyson and Wordsworth – 4 key events
- Choose 3 or more of these events and include detailed information about them e.g., key people involved, cause(s) and consequence(s) of the event, where the event took place etc.
- Full sentences using a variety of connectives
- Use apostrophes correctly
- List sources used (bibliography)

Extension: Analyse your sources for reliability and bias. Link the events – is there a common theme? How are they linked?
