Wonderful Places

LO: To recognize the awe and wonder of the world

Task: Choose your own top 3 natural wonders of the world and explain what they are and why you have chosen them. A natural wonder is something the world has created itself (physical), rather than a man-made object.

Look at the website <https://www.worldatlas.com/articles/the-seven-natural-wonders-of-the-world.html> which explains seven natural wonders of the world.

Use the Internet, magazines (for example National Geographic) and books to choose your own three natural wonders of the world. You may also have visited somewhere you feel is a natural wonder.

Include a picture (printed or drawn), describe where each is located in the world (country and continent) and explain why you have chosen them. Present your work neatly and clearly. Be creative!

Success Criteria:

- Described the location of three of your own natural wonders of the world (country and continent. You could also describe where they are located in that country for example south-east, or north of...northern hemisphere or latitudinal and longitudinal points)
- Included a picture or image of the wonder.
- Explained the reasons for your choice using high level vocabulary and accurate punctuation.
- Presented your work neatly and clearly.
- Written in pen and drawn pictures in pencil, using pencil crayons only for colour.

Extension: There are a number of extension activities you could complete. For example: Write about more than three natural wonders; record the locations of each wonder onto a world map using labels or a key; write a report for the National geographic magazine about one of the wonders.
