Comparing Countries

LO: To investigate what it means to be British and compare with your views of Uganda.

Task: What does it mean to be British how does our life compare with people from Uganda?

Suggested activities and time:

1. Use the Internet to search for the word 'Britain' and 'British' (20mins)
2. Use the Internet to search for the word 'Uganda' and 'Ugandan' (20mins)
3. Include some of your own ideas - What does being British mean to you? What do you think the country of Uganda is like? Talk to your family as well (20mins)
4. Make a draft of your display idea (20mins)
5. Create your final version (30mins)

Success Criteria:

- Use the Internet to search for the word 'Britain' and 'British'
- Use the Internet to search for the word 'Uganda' and 'Ugandan'
- Include some of your own ideas
- Include pictures and words/sentences.
- Present your work clearly and neatly with accurate spelling and use of capital letters for names of places.
- Be creative in your ideas.
- Think about our culture as well as buildings and people e.g., politeness.

Ideas:

A wordscape using words you think mean Britain/British - you could use a piece of software called Wordle at www.wordle.net

A poem with images - Benjamin Zephaniah has written a similar one called 'The British'

A montage (collection of) images with words to explain your ideas

A picture drawn on the Paint software

A drawing of words or images to show your ideas
