If you feel God is everywhere, how can you put that across? In a painting, collage, poetry or some other design?

If you are still searching for answers – how can that shown?

Year 8 – be imaginative, this is a really difficult question that will need a lot of thought and effort.

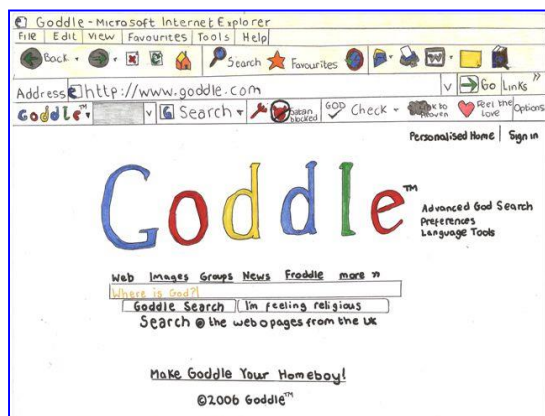
How will you be successful?
