

Year 6 - French - Enrichment Activity - Biography

Core Task: to write a biography of a famous French person (in English).

Extension Task: include pictures to illustrate some of the key people, places and events

Core Vocabulary: third person, past tense, time connectives, dates,

Extension Vocabulary: magic three, rhetorical questions, commands/instructions, adverbs (quickly, amazingly, brilliantly), adjectives to describe the people, places and activities.

Hints and Helps:

Choose someone that you are interested in - sports' person, actor, historical figure, chef, writer, creator of a cartoon character or an artist. Spend some time researching the facts about the famous French person and make notes of the main things. Remember that you don't need to know everything, but what made them the person they are today - the people and events that helped them achieve their goals for which they then became famous.

Success Criteria:

- ☐ Use the third person - he/she/they/Zinédine/Céline/Uderzo/Victor Hugo/Monet
- ☐ Use the past tense - jumped, bounced, grew, dreaded ...
- ☐ Use time connectives to sequence the paragraphs and key information
- ☐ Clear paragraphs
- ☐ A range of punctuation - . ! ? : , (lists and clauses) ; ... " " - ()
- ☐ Use apostrophes to show a missing letter (don't) and possession (Raymond's Mum)
- ☐ Include key dates, names of people and places
- ☐ Use capital letters for the names of people and places
- ☐ Pictures with captions (You may use ICT for this)
- ☐ Adverbs
- ☐ Adjectives
- ☐ Capital letters for the names of people and places
