

Internet Research Task Week **beginning 29th July**

Now that you know how to search the internet effectively to find information, I would like you to **research a topic** that you are interested in.

This week I would like you to think about your topic. It could be something that you are really interested in, or it could be something on the news that you have heard about that you would like to find out more about, it could also be something that you don't know much about and would like to find out more. I would probably find out about a period of history that I don't know much about.

When you are doing your research, you need to collect information for use when writing up. You can copy and paste at this stage, but you will then use this information to write in your own words.

Make sure that you use **reliable websites**.

Write the **URL of every website** that you use.

You can write notes in a book, or use Word to put all of your notes in for now.

Week beginning 6th July

You are now going to use your notes to write up your information.

Think about how you will set it out to make it interesting for the reader. Think about your **audience**, who do you want this work for, is it a younger child or an adult?

You will want to **plan** first so you know what will go into each section.

Decide how you want to write it up. Word, PowerPoint or on paper?

Put your information into an order. If you are doing something historical, is it in chronological order?

Think about what will go into each paragraph. Make sure that your information doesn't jump around too much making it harder to understand or not too rambling so you don't get to the point.

Are you going to add any pictures to your work?
